## Re: Summer Term 2015 Revision and Examinations

I would like to take this opportunity to get in touch with you as parents of year 11 pupils. As you know this term is very important for your child and therefore I would like to reinforce the message that Ysgol Tryfan is here to support all its pupils during this crucial period.

The formal GCSE examinations in the school hall start next Friday, May 8th. All pupils will have received their examination timetable by now of course - but if your child has mislaid the timetable then he/she should request a new copy from Mr Dyfrig Jones, the deputy head. A copy of the general Year 11 GCSE timetable is on the school's website so that you can check it or print it out as necessary. This timetable will also be available through the school's Twitter account. Yet having said this it is important that all pupils follow his/her personal individual timetable to ensure that there is no confusion.

Year 11 pupils are expected to be at school every day for the rest of this half-term. Lessons will be held as usual to support year 11 when they do not have exams and that provision will continue until Friday, May 22nd. Some subjects will organise additional revision sessions before particular examinations.

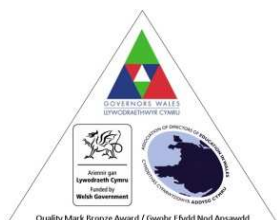
We intend to hold an official leaving ceremony for year 11 pupils on the last Friday afternoon before half term, May 22, in the school hall. Then following the Whitsun holidays they are not compelled to return to their lessons but only attend school for exams. But having said this, all pupils may return to school to receive the support and guidance of their teachers at any time during this period.
